2021 Amendments to Rules & Regulations pertaining to PhD Program

The following amendments have been approved by Research Council and Boar of Governors of PES University in the meetings held on Feb 3rd, 2021 and Feb 19th, 2021 respectively.

1. Modifications to admission process, eligibility criteria for research programs:

Proposal for modification in the eligibility criteria for admission into research programs of the university has been accepted.

2. Changes in overall Course work credits for PhD program:

Modifications to the PhD course work with a new credit scheme for Ph.D. program, arising due to introduction of a new 2 credit course Research & Publication Ethics (RPE) as a compulsory course for all newly admitted Ph.D. scholars as per UGC D.O. No.F-1-1/2018 dated December, 2019, has been accepted.
